Responsibilities

The faculty member will be required to:

Teach 9 online classes per year;

Advise students;

Assess, assist, and guide online adjunct sociology faculty under the direction of the department chair;

Engage in curriculum development;

Demonstrate professional development related to online teaching and course development;

Be able to teach traditional and non-traditional age students;

Demonstrate the ability to use discipline-related instructional technology; and

Participate in department and program efforts to support online students and online adjunct faculty.

Qualifications

Required/Minimum Qualification(s):

Doctorate degree in sociology from a regionally accredited institution with appropriate credentials/hours to teach sociology courses.

The applicant will have extensive experience with online teaching, online course development, online teaching pedagogy, and with non-traditional students.

Preferred Qualifications(s):

Preference will be given to applicants with demonstrated experience with assessment and/or evaluation of online teachers and/or courses.
