The Department of Sociology at Fayetteville State University invites applications for a tenure track position as Assistant Professor of Sociology to begin fall 2017. We are seeking applicants who can teach social statistics, data analysis, and research methods in the classroom setting and online. Applicants will also be able to teach classes in their area of specialty. Fayetteville State University is a constituent institution of the University of North Carolina and the second-oldest public institution of higher education in the state. Founded in 1867 as the Howard School for the education of African Americans, today FSU serves a growing student body of approximately 6,000 and ranks among the nation's most diverse campus communities. Fayetteville is located in the scenic Cape Fear River Valley of North Carolina, between the Blue Ridge Mountains and the Atlantic Ocean. Residents of Fayetteville enjoy mild temperatures, four distinct seasons, a low cost of living, and easy access to beautiful Carolina beaches.

Successful applicants will be part of a cohesive team of culturally diverse faculty that works closely with students as mentors in our undergraduate and graduate programs. A Ph.D. in Sociology is required at time of employment, but ABD candidates who expect to complete their degree before the start date will be considered. Applicants must be willing to participate in our online course development and instruction. Applicants will also engage in research and publication, and service to the university, community, and profession. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
