

Assistant Professor of Sociology – Charleston Southern University

Charleston Southern University invites applications for an Assistant Professor of Sociology. Charleston Southern seeks candidates who are professing Christians, committed to excellence in teaching, scholarship and service. They should support the goals of a strong liberal arts education and be willing to explore with students the integration of faith and learning.

Qualifications: An earned doctorate in Sociology from an accredited institution, a minimum of two years relevant college teaching experience, a background of teaching or working in the human services field, and the ability to promote the aims of liberal arts education in general education and within the discipline are required.

Responsibilities: The course load is 12 credit hours per major semester including undergraduate courses in Principles of Sociology, Social Problems, Sociology of Religion, Introduction to Human Services, Urban Sociology, and courses in the candidate's specialty area. Involvement within the department, student advising, supervising internships and experiential learning experiences, working with the Alpha Kappa Delta chapter, campus service and professional development are required. The applicant should have an interest in guiding student research projects and have a passion for undergraduate teaching.

Application Process: Candidates should complete the online application and attach a cover letter and curriculum vitae in a single document. Entering untrue or inaccurate information will result in disqualification for consideration of vacant positions or subsequent termination after hire. Review of credentials will begin immediately. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply. Prior to a final offer of employment, the selected candidate will be required to submit to a background check including, but not limited to, employment verification, educational and other credential verification.
