

Department Chair and Associate Professor or Professor of Criminal Justice

The College of Arts and Sciences at Texas A&M International University seeks a Department Chair and an Associate Professor or Professor of Criminal Justice to begin Fall 2018.

Responsibilities include oversight and management of the Department of Social Sciences, which encompasses academic programs in Criminal Justice, Political Science, Sociology, Public Administration, and Geography. The department is one of the largest academic units within the college, has twenty-two full-time faculty members, and offers both undergraduate and graduate degrees. The Department Chair reports directly to the Dean of the College of Arts & Sciences, teaches one class a semester, and serves on a 12 month appointment.

Required Qualifications:

The successful candidate should hold a PhD in Criminal Justice or related field, qualify for appointment as an associate or full professor, and possess outstanding interpersonal, leadership, management, and administrative skills and experience. The candidate should also have an active research agenda, be committed to mentoring department faculty, and committed to undergraduate and graduate instruction, scholarship and publication, grant writing, and service to the university and community.

Preferred Qualifications:

Preference will be given to candidates with at least 2 years of administrative experience.

Application Procedure: Review of applications will begin in late November and will continue until the position is filled. Applications received by this date will be given priority. The position start date can be Spring 2018 or Fall 2018. Salary is competitive and commensurate with experience and qualifications.
