

POSITION: VISITING SCHOLAR

The Department of Sociology at Morehouse College invites applications for a visiting scholar position for the 2019-2020 academic year. This is a one-year academic position with the possibility of renewal. The scholar will engage in teaching and/or mentored research and community outreach/community-based participatory research, distributed according to the scholar's areas of expertise and the Department's priorities. The successful candidate should have at least 15 graduate hours in sociology or a related social science discipline, qualifying him or her to address Department priorities.

Preference will be given to those with experience teaching Quantitative Methods/Statistics. Secondary areas could include one or two of the following sub-fields: Sociological Theory, Cultural Anthropology, Medical Sociology, Education, and Globalization/Development. The successful candidate is expected to teach a 3/3 teaching load. Teaching expectations for the Fall 2019 semester would include Sociological Theory and Cultural Anthropology.

The dates of employment are August 1, 2019 – May 30, 2020.

APPLICATION

The application consists of the following:

1. *A letter of application* describing the candidate's qualifications and explaining why his/her qualifications are appropriate to address the stated Department priorities (no more than 2 pages);
2. *A current curriculum vitae or resume*
3. *A statement of the candidate's philosophy of education* (no more than 2 pages)
4. *The names and contact information of three references* who can speak to the candidate's qualifications described in the letter of application
5. Candidates may also share *sample syllabi* (no more than 2 courses) and *samples of scholarship* (no more than 2 samples)
